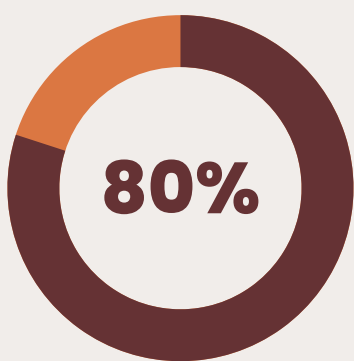

Cancer patients do not complete their treatment due to **financial constraints**

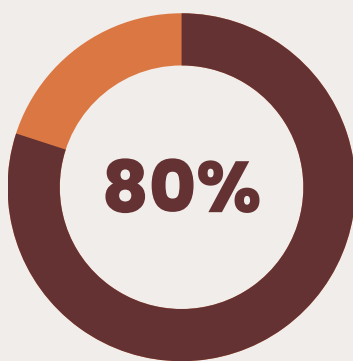

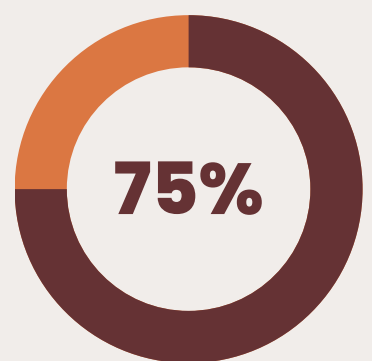
LEADING CAUSE OF DEATH IN LMICS
